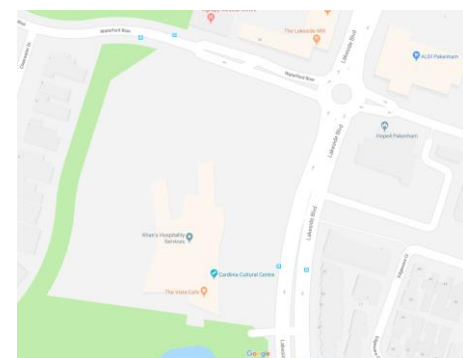

Location & Access

Cardinia Cultural Centre is located at 40 Lakeside Boulevard, Pakenham, Victoria. Cardinia Cultural Centre Studios are located next to our Arts Foyer entry. The venue is flat and stair access is not required. We have a dedicated car park that is free of charge with access from Waterford Rise. Alternatively, take a train on the Pakenham line and get off at the Cardinia Road station. From there it's a 20min walk along Shearwater Boulevard.



Studio Space

A rectangular shaped room that can be divided into two rooms with a movable dividing wall. A Harlequin Activity triple sandwich fully floating floor system.

Room Dimensions

Studio 1 9.2m x 6.4m Roof Height 3.52m

Studio 2 9.2m x 6.7m Roof Height 3.07m to 6.09m

Drapery

Full Length curtain at one end of each studio to cover full length mirrors when not in use

Climate Control

Each studio has individual temperature set climate control that can be set by the user within a specified range

Floor

Fully sprung flat floor (no rake). Harlequin Activity triple sandwich floating floor Tarkett (Tarkett is non removable)

Screwing into the floor is not allowed under any circumstances

Lighting

House Lights

Separate control in each studio.

3-Phase Power

The Audio is distributed by a Q-Sys analogue and digital audio distribution system integrated with a Crestron media system for video integration and touch screen user integration control.

Control Inputs

Located in each Studio. Rooms can be controlled as joined or separate

Each studio's inputs include

1x RCA (Stereo)

1x 3.5mm Mini Jack

1x 3pin XLR

Crestron 5" touch panel – wall mounted on the same wall the Display Panel

EWP Operating Restrictions: Operators must provide a current license. Must have a licenced operator as well as a licensed spotter. Ply sheets must be laid over floor to protect the surface

Ladders: 1 x 2.4m Fiberglass double sided step ladder
